



PURPOSE OF STUDY:

- To investigate future-in-the-past time variation in Spain and Latin America using a controlled preference task, given differences between the regions for future-time expression and the infrequency of the target structure
 - Expression of the future from the perspective of the past: variation between periphrastic future in the imperfect (PFI) and conditional

- Examples:

Yo no me imaginaba que el uno de noviembre iba a estar la gente en la playa en bañador... (PFI)

‘I didn’t imagine that on November first people were going to be at the beach in bathing suits.’ PRESEEA, Seville

Me apunté y dije que iría de tal día a tal día, y me fui a la Feria de Sevilla.... (conditional)

‘I signed up and said that I would go over those days, and I went to the Seville Fair....’ PRESEEA, Seville
